

Draw Format 2023 State Championships

Associations wishing to compete at the State Championships are to nominate their teams by the specified due date.

Teams cannot nominate to a preferred division for the State Championships. If a team wishes to move either up or down a division to which they are seeded to, they must complete a Request for Division Exemption form and return to Basketball Queensland before the due date for entering teams into the State Championships.

The final league standings of each regional competition (CQJBC, NQJBC & SQJBC) excluding of finals will ultimately determine which Division a team will be seeded to.

Twelve (12) and ten (10) team scenarios have been outlined in this document. Wherever possible 12 teams will be allocated to Divisions 1 and 2, while any number of teams can participate in Division 3 and/or 4 if it is conducted. Whilst 12-team draws are preferred for Divisions 1 and 2, Basketball Queensland reserves the right to alter the format of each Division depending on numbers of all team nominations.

Only teams who have competed in the CQJBC, NQJBC & SQJBC competitions for the respective age group, may nominate to the State Championships.

A condition of nominating to the State Championships is that all teams accept the format chosen by Basketball Queensland and acknowledge that they must play under this with no option to challenge it.

Qualification

Division 1

Twelve (12) teams can contest Division 1 with ten (10) automatic seedings to be given as follows:

- TOP 6 in SQJBC Premier League
- TOP 3 in NQJBC
- 1st in CQJBC

The last two positions in Division 1 will be allocated to 7th and 8th placed SQJBC Premier League teams unless contested in the Wildcard Challenge by the 1st and 2nd placed teams in SQJBC Southern Cup.

Division 2

This division can be conducted in two different formats depending on the number of teams nominated for the State Championships. Basketball Queensland reserves the right to alter the below formats in Division 2 and any lower Divisions.



If 20 or more teams in total are seeded to Divisions 2 and lower:

Twelve (12) teams will contest Division 2 with 10 (ten) automatic seedings to be given as follows:

- TOP 6 in SQJBC Southern Cup
- 4th, 5th & 6th in NQJBC
- 2nd in CQJBC

The last two positions in Division 2 will be allocated to 7th and 8th placed SQJBC Southern Cup teams unless contested in the Wildcard Challenge by the 1st and 2nd placed teams in SQJBC Challenge Cup.

If 19 or less teams in total are seeded to Divisions 2 and lower:

All nominated teams will contest Division 2 and there will be no Division 3 conducted for this age group. The format and seedings for Division 2 under this scenario will be at the discretion of Basketball Queensland.

Division 3

A minimum of eight (8) teams are required to conduct a Division 3 in an age group, meaning at least twenty (20) teams in total must be entered for Divisions 2 and 3 to be held. Insufficient numbers (i.e. 19 teams or less) will result in an expanded Division 2-only competition being conducted.

If conducted, Division 3 will generally be made up of teams from:

- SQJBC Challenge Cup & Development Cup
- NQJBC 7th place and onward
- CQJBC 3rd place and onward

Exemptions to Division's seeding

Any team who wishes to move either up or down a division to which they are seeded to, must complete a Request for Division Exemption form and return to Basketball Queensland before the due date.

All requests for an exemption will be evaluated on a case by case basis, however, the request for a divisional change will only be considered if the number of nominations and subsequent draw formats allow for a change.

If a team wishes to drop down a division, in order to evaluate each request, the following requirements **<u>must</u>** be met:

Under 12 & 14

The team has been beaten by an average of 30 points in **every** game of a representative competition against the same standard of teams.



Under 16 & 18

The team has been beaten by approximately 40 points in **every** game of a representative competition against the same standard of teams.

Any team who wishes to move up a division will be evaluated on a case by case basis, provided there is room in the above division.

Teams must acknowledge that they may only be able to play in the Division that they are seeded to.

Pool Allocations & Team Rankings

In **Division 1** under a 12-team scenario the pool allocations will be as follows:

In **Division 2** under a 12-team scenario the pool allocations will be as follows:

The above principles will continue to be used if either Division is reduced to 10 or 11 teams, however teams may be required to change pools if the reduction causes an imbalance. Teams may also be promoted in the absence of teams that were ranked higher than them.

Pool Allocations may be altered if two teams from the same Association are in the same Division and are seeded in the same pool. Any alterations will be at the discretion of Basketball Queensland.

Seedings for **Division 3 and/or Division 4** will be at the discretion of Basketball Queensland and will take into consideration the results of all regional competitions (i.e. CQJBC, NQJBC & SQJBC).

Competition Format

Division 1 and **Division 2** competitions consisting of 12 teams will play a round robin competition of 5 games and then cross over with the opposite pool to play off for either 1st – 4th, 5th – 8th, 9th – 12th.



Competitions consisting of 11 teams will play to a format similar to the 12-team version. The only difference is due to the odd number of teams, the bottom two in one pool (5th & 6th) and bottom in the other (5th) after the round robin phase will contest either a secondary pool or a modified semi-final format to determine places 9th - 11th.

Competitions consisting of 10 teams will play a round robin competition of 4 games and will then play either a top 4 or 5th - 10th. The top 4 will play a cross over semi-final then a medal game. Remaining teams will be put in new pools of 3 to play a round robin competition before crossing over and playing for positions 5th - 10th.

Division 3 and/or Division 4 competitions will also begin play in a round robin competition, however the format for the Division will only be decided after the number of teams participating is known.

Basketball Queensland reserves the right to determine the re-structure of a Division's competition format.



Wildcard Challenge

Wildcard Challenges can only be conducted in the same regional areas, i.e. SQJBC v SQJBC and NQJBC v NQJBC.

SQJBC

The 7th and 8th placed teams in SQJBC Premier League can be challenged by the 1st and 2nd placed teams in SQJBC Southern Cup for the final positions in Division 1.

The 7th and 8th placed teams in SQJBC Southern Cup can be challenged by the 1st and 2nd placed teams in SQJBC Challenge Cup for the final positions in Division 2.

There is no SQJBC Wildcard Challenge to be held for positions in Division 3 and/or 4.

Please note if more than two teams nominate to challenge for positions in either Wildcard Challenge, only the two highest ranked teams at the time of the Wildcard Challenge can contest.

CQJBC

There is no Wildcard Challenge in the CQJBC as the winner of Division 2 (if conducted) will most likely be seeded into the same Division as the last placed team in Division 1.

NQJBC

The team that finishes first in Division 2 may challenge the third placed team in Division 1 if there are three teams in Division 1. This challenge will take place on the last round of the NQJBC season.

Wildcard Challenges may not be conducted if teams relinquish their position in a division.
