U18 Team nomination acceptance is conditional upon:

- Associations are financial as at the nomination closing date of Monday 28 November 2022.
- All team officials (inclusive of Coach, Assistants and Manager) being registered to the association's SportsTG.
- Associations must supply <u>two (2)</u> competent scorebench officials for each of their games. Scorebench passes will no longer be issued due to the misuse of these at previous events.
- All mandatory fields in all nomination forms and documentation **must** be completed.

All team officials and referees must fulfil the necessary requirements of the Commission for Children and Young People and Child Guardian Act 2000. Please refer to the **Blue Card Requirements for State Championships** document for who is required to have a Blue Card/Exemption Card.

Note: All team officials should also have signed an Association Member Protection Declaration when taking on their position with the team. Signed Declarations should be retained by the Association.

U18 Team Nomination - Stage 1

Associations will be emailed the JotForm link and will need to confirm which of their teams who have competed at the regional competitions (CQJBC, NQJBC & SQJBC) will be nominated for the State Championships.

Every team must have a manager and coach registered with contact details sent to BQ to be eligible for nomination.

U18 Team Nomination - Stage 2

Associations will be emailed a copy of their team lists for confirmation by the due date at the end of this form. Any changes after this date will need to be approved by BQ.

The fees for nominating all teams will be due at this stage. Associations no longer need to deposit \$100 per team for the State Championships.

Referees:

Travel

Travel arrangements to and from the U18 State Championships for all referees will be arranged by BQ with the cost applied to all participating teams in addition to the nomination fee.

Accommodation

To ensure all referees are receiving the same education, <u>all referees</u> are required to stay at the accommodation provided by BQ.

Important Information:

- BQ reserves the right to decline nominations from Associations that fail to complete all mandatory
 fields of their nomination. Contact details (including mobile and e-mail) MUST be provided for Team
 Managers & Team Coaches in order for BQ to communicate important information to them prior to
 and during the event. Please make sure all details are correct, BQ will not take responsibility for those
 managers who do not receive important information due to the wrong contact details being provided
 by Associations.
- Late Nominations may be accepted at the sole discretion of the BQ Competition Manager. A non-refundable late nomination fee of \$100 per team must be paid before the nomination will be considered. Late nominations may not be accepted if, in the opinion of BQ, the draw cannot accommodate or will be adversely affected by the late entry.

- Players must be within the prescribed age group as of 31 December 2023 for their respective age championship. For the Under 18 State Championships players must be born in 2006 or later. Associations should retain a copy of the player's proof of age.
- All uniforms <u>must</u> display the Basketball Queensland Logo. The BQ logo must be worn in a visible position
 on playing singlets (generally on the right breast). Failure to have the BQ logo on playing singlets will incur
 a \$200.00 fine. Uniforms are to be numbered 0,00 and any number between 1 and 99 in accordance with
 the State Championships Policy.
- All teams <u>must</u> have two sets of uniforms which are distinctly light and dark.

Photography:

BQ has made an ongoing commitment to encourage participation in sport and physical activity. At the 2023 State Championships BQ aims to continue promoting the value of an active and healthy lifestyle by undertaking marketing & promotional activities. During this event BQ will produce and circulate media releases, web site updates, newsletters, & flyers. For these purposes BQ will again have professional photographers present at the event taking action & team photos.

As part of registering to participate at the State Championships, all players and their parents/guardians acknowledge and accept that players will be photographed by BQ and their authorised photographers. When signing and submitting the Player Registration Confirmation form to BQ (Stage 2 of Team Nomination), the association acknowledges that photographers will be present and that all players, unless otherwise advised with valid reason, have no objections to their photos being taken and published in one or any of the collateral items listed above.

No flash photography is permitted in the stadium at any time. No persons with the exception of the official photographer and Event Staff are permitted to photograph from the sidelines (unless in spectator seating at the sideline) or the baselines.

Divisions & Competition Formats:

Teams cannot nominate to a preferred division for the State Championships. If a team wishes to move either up or down a division to which they are seeded to, they must complete a Request for Division Exemption form and return to Basketball Queensland before **Monday 28 November 2022.** BQ reserves the right to determine the final allocation of teams to divisions based on performances in BQ regional competitions and any Wildcard Challenge.

More information regarding divisions and formats is contained within the 2023 Draw Format Overview which can be downloaded from the State Championships page of the BQ website.

As part of nominating for the State Championships, teams accept the format chosen by BQ and acknowledge that they must play under this with no option to challenge it.
